4. The Clinical Qualifier will open up and you will select the values appropriate for the problem. For example, if the problem you expanded was Gout, you can select the site, etiology, encounter type, chronicity, laterality, and presence of tophus. As you make your selections, the ICD-10 descriptions narrow down to the most appropriate option.

5. When the Clinical Qualifier narrows down

completely, you can simply select the prob-

lem and it will add it to the patient's active

problem list.
