

Signify Health In-Home Assessments

Our BlueCross BlueShield MA programs have partnered with Signify Health to aid in reaching homebound patients. If Signify Health services are needed, a licensed provider can travel to the patient's home to complete an in-home assessment. This service can help to ensure homebound patients are being assessed, and it can help encourage patients to stay engaged with their PCP. Signify Health sends results of the assessments back to patients and their attributed PCP.

Candidates for Signify Health services may include:

- Patients who do not have a PCP or evidence of a provider visit in the last year.
- Patients with gaps in chronic condition or comorbidity documentation
- Patients with use of medication that does not fit a documented diagnosis *Note: Patients are not required to participate. Signify will recommend PCP follow-up.*



Assessment Components

The provider performs a comprehensive history and physical, as well as the following, as appropriate:

- iFOBT/FIT Test Kit
- HbA1c Test Kit
- Diabetic Retinal Eye Exam
- Bone Mineral Density Testing

- Urine Microalbumin Test Kit
- Peripheral Artery Disease Testing
- Spirometry Testing
