

## Order D/C Medications

From the Meds tab on the Clinical Desktop, you have the choice to Record D/C or Order D/C. Although Allscripts attempts to send a discontinue message to the pharmacy when Order D/C is selected, our local pharmacies do not receive that message.

1. Highlight to choose a medication. It will turn gray.
2. Select Record D/C.

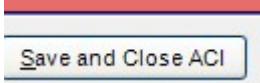
3. Enter Status Change Reason.

5. You can have the nurse call the pharmacy to D/C the medication and prevent future refills from being filled. But you also have the option to include the D/C information in the Pharmacy Instructions for a new medication. The EHR team has confirmed that the Pharmacy will receive these messages.
- In this example the Paroxetine is being replaced by Escitalopram. So the Paroxetine has been recorded as D/C. And now, the script for Escitalopram is being ordered.
  - Enter the D/C information in the Pharmacy Instructions (*Image i*)
  - Save and Close ACI.
