Appropriate Testing for Pharyngitis (CWP)

Appropriate Testing for Pharyngitis (CWP) is one of the new quality measures for the 2021 BCBS Commercial program. The goal of this measure is for patients ages 3 years and older to have a strep test done before receiving an antibiotic for a related pharyngitis diagnosis. Compliance for this measure is based on if the strep test was performed, not the results. Documentation of the in-office strep test should be included on the claim form to prevent the gap.

Sample diagnoses may include:

Acute pharyngitis
Acute tonsillitis
Streptococcal pharyngitis
Acute streptococcal pharyngitis

Exclusions from this measure include:

Patients in hospice

Patients with the following comorbidities: HIV, malignant neoplasm, emphysema, COPD, and disorders of the immune system
