



Ballad Health's Center for Post-COVID Care

Ballad Health has recently launched their Center for Post-COVID Care (CPCC), a combined virtual and in-person care resource for patients age 12 and older who are struggling with post-COVID symptomology. The CPCC utilizes a comprehensive intake assessment to help identify post-COVID symptoms, and if further evaluation is warranted, patients will be referred appropriately. The CPCC can provide services such as virtual support groups and care navigation between primary and specialty care providers.

Patients who could qualify for the CPCC include those who have recovered from COVID-19 and experience lingering symptoms, such as:

- Behavioral health issues, such as PTSD, insomnia, anxiety, and depression
- Chronic fatigue
- Fever
- GI symptoms
- Joint pain
- Memory loss
- Mood issues
- Trouble breathing, residual pulmonary manifestations and coughs
- Vision problems
- Weakness and poor endurance
- Myocardial injury
- Autonomic function: pain, hypercoagulability
- Impaired renal function
