



## BCBS Commercial Reporting-Only Measures

Our Blue Cross Blue Shield Commercial Program now includes the following **reporting-only** quality measures:

### Adult Immunization Status

Patients 19 years of age and older should be up-to-date on recommended routine vaccines for influenza, tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis (Td or Tdap), zoster, and pneumococcal.

- **Flu shot** – annually
- **Herpes zoster vaccine** – one or two shots at age 50 older (one dose of the live vaccine or two doses of the recombinant vaccine at least 28 days apart)
- **Tdap/Td vaccine** - every 10 years
- **Pneumococcal vaccine** (PCV 13 or PPSV23) - age 60 and older

### Kidney Health Evaluation for Patients with Diabetes

Patients 18-85 years of age with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) should receive a kidney health evaluation, defined by at least one estimated glomerular filtration rate (eGFR) and at least one urine albumin-creatinine ratio (uACR), identified by a quantitative urine albumin test and a urine creatinine test with service dates 4 or less days apart during the measurement year.

*Note:* Members should receive both tests during the measurement year, but these can be on the same or different dates of service.

*While both measures are reporting only for 2021, they may become one of our quality metrics for 2022.*
