

## **TennCare Episodes of Care**






TennCare's Episodes of Care program focuses on acute or specialistdriven health care delivered during a specified time period to treat a single physical or behavioral condition.

Episodes reward high-quality care, promote the use of clinical pathways and evidence-based guidelines, encourage coordination, and reduce ineffective and/or inappropriate care.

Episodes are assigned to a "quarterback," which is the physician or facility who is responsible for the specific condition. The "episodes" are triggered by specific claims, and encompass ALL costs related to that condition over a pre-determined time frame.



Future QI Weeklies will focus on specific episodes and will be sent to the appropriate quarterbacks.
