Once the document has been scanned in, the system will automatically add the scanned document to the Consent section of the "i" icon on the patient banner. From the "i" icon, click the consent hyperlink. To view the consent, single click and choose View Patient Consent Document.



Using the "i" button is a quick way to look up important scanned information. For example, using the "i" to access HIPAA forms can quickly inform clinic staff of who they can speak to regarding a patient's care.
