Documenting Multiple Blood Pressures

If a patient's blood pressure is over 140/90, please take the blood pressure a second time.

If a patient's blood pressure remains elevated, please take the blood pressure a third time.

Always, go back to the **Daily Schedule** and double click on the patient's name to enter the blood pressure reading a second or third time. This connects the information to the appointment.

When entering the blood pressure, ensure that it says *Appointment* at the top right on the Order Details.

Note to provider- Don't sign the note until the 2nd and 3rd blood pressures are taken and loaded into the note. Sometimes it takes a minute for the note to refresh and load the blood pressure.

If the additional readings don't load into the note, *Save and Close* the note and reopen. That should refresh the info.
