

# Well Child Visits

**Description:** Percentage of enrolled patients who were of age during the measurement year and who had the following well child visits.

**First 15 Months-** Percentage of members who turned 15 months of age during the measurement year and who had 6+ well child visits with a PCP during their first 15 months of life

**18, 24, and 30 Months-** Percentage of members who turned 35 months old during the measurement period who had at least one well child visit within each of the following intervals:

- 2 weeks before 18 month up to 2 weeks before 24 months
- 2 weeks before 24 month up to 2 weeks before 30 months
- 2 weeks before 30 months up to 35 months

**Ages 3-6 years-** Percentage of members 3-6 years of age who had one or more well child visits with a PCP during the measurement year.

**Ages 7-11 years-** Percentage of members 7-11 years of age who had one or more well child visits with a PCP during the measurement year

**Ages 12-21 years-** Percentage of members 12-21 years of age who had at least one comprehensive well care visit with a PCP

**Denominator:** Equals Eligible Population

**Numerator (First 15 Months):** Seven separate numerators are calculated, corresponding to the number of patient who received 0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 or more complete well child visits on different dates of service, with a PCP during their first 15 months of life. The well child visit must occur with a PCP, but the practitioner does not have to be assigned to the patient.

**Numerator (All other age categories):** At least one well child visit with a PCP during the measurement year. The well child visit must occur with a PCP, but the practitioner does not have to be assigned to the patient.

**Exclusions:** None

The following are separate quality measures but should be done at the well child visit, when appropriate:

- Weight assessment and counseling for nutrition and physical activity
- Immunizations for Adolescents (Meningococcal, Tdap, HPV)
- Childhood Immunizations- (Dtap, IPV, MMR, HiB, HepB, VZV, PCV, HepA, RV, Influenza)
